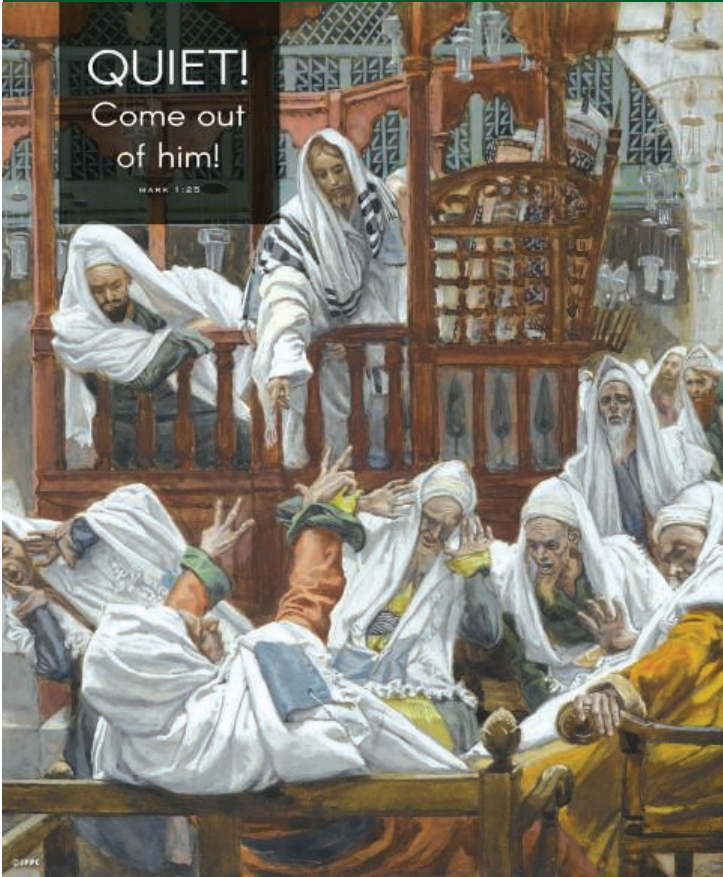

### Reading I: Deuteronomy 18: 15-20

Prophets will be “raised up” as the need arises. Then the people must listen to these authentic prophets called by Yahweh to succeed Moses.

### Reading II: 1 Corinthians 7: 32-35

Paul offers clear advice to both the married and the unmarried in the community. Yet he does not impose any solution, as they strive for true “adherence to the Lord.”

### The Gospel: Mark 1: 21-28

Mark concludes his stories of Jesus’ healing with the tag that “His fame spread everywhere,” even though it sometimes did so against Our Lord’s will. Above all, He taught “with authority.”

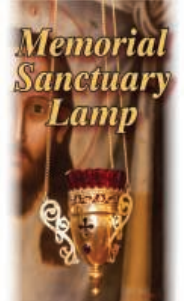

“Many people know someone personally who is suffering because of an abortion. 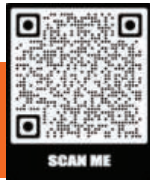

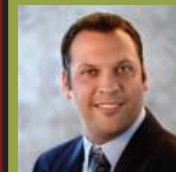
